South African Wine

In 1655 a shipment of grape vine cuttings, mainly from France, arrived in Table Bay and soon after the first vineyards were planted. In 1659 the first wine was made by commander Jan van Riebeeck.

Vine cuttings were distributed amongst the farmers and they moved further inland to plant new vineyards and forge a future for themselves as wine farmers.

Today, the yearly production among South African's wine regions is usually around 10 million hL (264 million US gallons) which regularly puts South Africa among the top ten wine producing countries in the world.

Some of the wines on our Wine List are local Karoo wine from Calitzdorp, and we also have wine from the Western Cape wine region including organic wine from Vredendal.

Boplaas Family Vineyard is based in Calitzdorp at the foot of the Swartberg Mountains. Current owner Carel Nel, is a Cape Wine Master and cellar master since 1980. Grapes have been grown on Boplaas for the making of wine and brandy for more than 150 years.

De Krans Wine Cellar is situated along the Gamka River Valley near Calitzdorp at the foothills of the Swartberg Mountains. The history of winemaking dates back to 1890.

Stellar Winery is South Africa's largest producer of fine organic, fair trade wines. The cellar is situated at Kys Halte, just outside Vredendal. Stellar sources organic grapes from a number of independent farms and make Live-a-Little organic wines.
